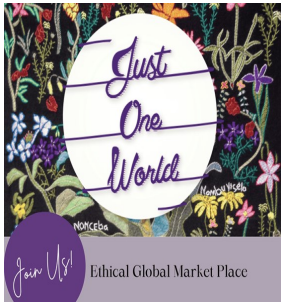
Games and Fellowship

Capital Fund Replenishment Drive Update

At the beginning of 2024 we had no money left in our Capital Reserve Fund. I am happy to report that today the balance in the Fund now stands at \$112,000 thanks to generous donations from congregation members and bequests. We anticipate about \$10,000 of spending still to come on the drainage improvement project, which leaves us with a healthy amount for future needs. (The 10-year Capital Plan foresees \$104,000 of upcoming expenses.) A big thank-you to all who have helped shore up the balance in this Fund and the sustainability of our beautiful property for some time to come! Although the Replenishment Drive has now ended, you are welcome and encouraged to donate to the Capital Reserve Fund through one-time donations or monthly PAR installments. Thanks!
