February is for Fellowship!

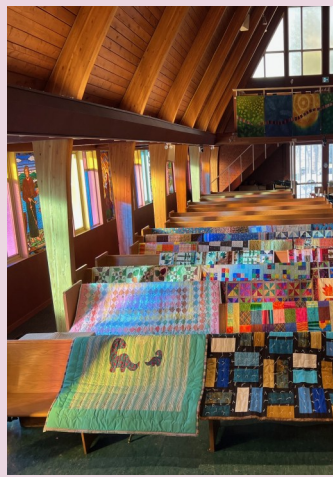
After a loooong January, It's time to reconnect and enjoy being with one another for conversation, socializing, snacking, and fun! Please consider
